Call to Order:

President Derek Bell called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Consent Agenda:

- Announce approval of September 14, 2019, Board meeting minutes via email.
- Manager's Report October 19, 2019 (attached with these minutes).
- Financial Report August 2019, September 2019
- Motion made by Jason H. and seconded by Sue V. to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

- 2020 Budget Work
 - The Budget Committee had their first meeting to go through the Budget for 2020.
 - Jason H. presented an over view of the Budget at this point.
 - Don't have information for income for Condo and UDI because dues for 2020 have not been determined yet or income for seasonals.
 - Don't have seasonal count.
 - o There are 11 seasonal openings for 2020.
 - No significant changes in 2020 Budget.
 - Adding more golf carts for 2020.
 - There will be 20 golf carts for rent.

- Harv's Electric will be putting in more charging stations for the carts
- Budget process is becoming easier as the records get cleaned up.
- GM, Anne, mentioned that Maintenance Manager, Larry, would like to see the amount for equipment increased.
- o Budget Committee to meet again before the next Board meeting on November 2.
- Staff wages will be discussed in Executive Session today.

• Projects Update

- o Activity Pool
 - Didn't get as far as we wanted on the pool because it is hard to find trades people to get estimates. Many calls have been made.
 - Splash, out of Green Bay, is working on an estimate for the tile work and can do the work in spring.
 - Carrico, the pool chemicals company, is working on an estimate for the pump repair or replacement.
 - There was mention of a seasonal that might be able to do the tile work.
 - Derek B. has the name of someone that may be able to give an estimate on the pump.
- o Hot Tub
 - Work has started on making the grate larger for the VGBA Code.
- Slide
 - Need to remove caulk and put on new gel coat.
 - Weather has been a problem.
 - Fisher, a company out of Eau Claire that did work for us before, was contacted to get an estimate for this work.
 - Anne will work over winter to find a company to do the work in May.
- o Plow Truck
 - Anne said it would help if she knew how much money is available for a plow truck.
 - Suggested that we allow up to \$35,000 for a plow truck (full package).
 - If a truck could be found, a plow for around \$8,000 and a dump box for about \$8,000-\$10,000 could be added.
 - Discussion of things the park needs:
 - Motors in pump room need upgrade.
 - Motors in pump room will need to be upgraded. 7 pumps at \$4,000 each = \$28,000
 - o Believe that this upgrade will be mandatory by 2021 but we don't have the documentation on that yet.
 - Pressure tank for fresh water system needs replacement = \$10,000
 - o Have 2 pressure tanks now.
 - We do not have a park model to replace next year.
 - Treasurer, Sue V., thinks we could find \$35,000 for a plow truck.
 - Motion made by Sue V. and seconded by Jason H. to allow up to \$35,000 to purchase a new plow truck.
 Motion carried unanimously.

- Store Siding
 - Bids to replace store siding:
 - \$17,000 bid for entire store siding replacement.
 - \$10,000 bid for entire store siding replacement. (This was rescinded.)
 - Volunteers have been working on the back wall of the store.
 - Total for windows, door, and siding for the entire store with volunteers doing the work = \$5,000.
 - Discussion of the new siding color. Looked at samples. Suggest earth tone similar to the north bathhouse.

• New Reservation System Update – StayList

- The set up was done faster than expected in 1 ½ weeks.
- o This week, Daniel, Gesika, and Anne will be involved in a video conference.
 - Will be implementing a plan for training.
- The old reservation system, Reserve America, will stay through November in case there are issues with the new system.
- o StayList is a very user friendly system.

• Phone Service

- We can get free phones from Camera Corner.
 - Set up and labor for the phones would cost \$2,500.
 - DataTech bid was about the same.
 - Still need bid from Camera Corner on the wiring and the other work that needs to be done.
 - Anticipate the bid from Camera Corner to be similar to Data Tech bid which was \$8,000.
 - We presently have 5 phones.
 - Camera Corner subcontracts electric work.
 - New phone system will improve sound and quality.
- Question whether we can get the phones from ATT.
 - When ATT came in, they wired our phones to the fiber optics.
 - The software is there but not the phones.
 - Fiber optics was free for the park.
 - They call that "Voice Over IP."
 - Phones go over the internet.
 - Paying for the service but not using it.
 - Can we get new phones through ATT?
 - Could we set up the new system through ATT?
 - What would be the wiring cost?
 - Anne will contact ATT and see if the phones can be upgraded through them and get the Voice Over IP system up and running.

• **Project Fund Discussion**

- o \$160,000 in Project Fund:
 - Have plans for \$137,000 of this amount for projects already. Some items include:
 - Horse barn spray foam estimated at \$8,000. This does not include walls, etc. Need ceiling in first. May need to complete this in parts.
 - Tiling work at pool.
 - Slides about \$1,500 on caulk and gel.
 - Second half payment on park model this year.
 - Don't have park model to replace next year.

Schopf's Snow Plowing

- o This was discussed at a previous meeting.
- Would only hire Schopf's for emergency plowing.
- o A document is being drafted for Schopf's to sign regarding this service.
- o Will pay Schopf's \$75/hour for plowing service.
- Don't have to plow seasonal areas or other parts of the park that are not being used in the winter.

NEW BUSINESS

• Public Camping Rates for 2020

- After the September Board meeting, the Board had discussions via email regarding the public camping rates for 2020.
- On September 19, 2019, Paul B. made a motion that was seconded by Paulette K. to increase public weekend and holiday rates 3%. Voting yes: Paulette K., Barrett S., Derek B., Paul B., Brian W., Jason H., John N. Voting no: Sue V. No reply: Mary P.S.

• **DUDI Followup**

- o Jason H. will be working on the list of DUDIs that was started 2 years ago.
- o Work was done at the Register of Deeds to see where the DUDIs are at. .
- o Anne has had some DUDIs turned in.
- Jason and Anne will work on the DUDI list after the November meeting to bring the information from 2 years ago up to date.

• National Electric Code

- It is not definite, but all the electric pedestals may need to be upgraded to GFCI at a cost of \$400 per pedestal on the public side.
 - The park pays dues to ARVC (National Association of RV Parks & Campgrounds) and they lobby for issues that are good for RV parks.
 - ARVC is working to get wording that protects campgrounds that says we don't have to do these upgrades.

Open Session

- Nancy L.
 - O Discussion on a place near Denmark that has a lot of plows for sale.
 - Derek B. know this person and will get more information.
 - o The back side of the store gets no sunlight so mold develops.
 - If there was clean stone there and branches trimmed, it would help eliminate some of the moisture which causes the mold.
